LIMPOPO RECORDS FIRST COVID-19 DEATH CASES OF HEALTHCARE WORKERS

Limpopo Health MEC Dr Phophi Ramathuba is saddened by the deaths of two doctors from COVID-19 related complications. The two doctors aged 57 and 47 respectively are the first cases of health care workers to die of COVID-19 related complications in the province. They were both General Practitioners working for their own independent practices. They died while receiving treatment at Netcare and Medi Clinic respectively.

The MEC has send out condolences to the families, friends and colleagues of the deceased.
